

Helping People Recover From Addiction

CREOKS Health Services has a dedicated team of medical and behavioral health professionals that offer effective and compassionate outpatient treatment for those who are dealing with opiate addiction and want help with recovery. We pride ourselves on giving quality care that enables participants to overcome drug addiction dependency and move forward to a happier and healthier life.

CREOKS Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)

Simply put, our program is designed to help people stop using opioids. Medication assisted treatment refers to the combined use of medications, counseling, and therapy to treat substance abuse disorders, overdoses, and help recovering addicts sustain their sobriety. This course of treatment provides instant relief of opioid cravings and withdrawals.

Opioid Use Disorders (OUD), is the addiction to opioid pain medications, heroin, or opium. Those who experience withdrawal symptoms, may be a candidate for the CREOKS MAT program. Often, MAT can manage withdrawal from opiates on an outpatient basis, without the need for a higher level of care.

A thorough assessment by our clinicians will determine if a person meets the criteria for MAT and that this level of care is appropriate. Safety and recovery is our primary concern and with three program locations, CREOKS is a great resource for those ready to get started.

Program Structure

The CREOKS MAT program has a philosophy of “harm reduction” toward recovery. While recognizing that relapse can be part of recovery, we provide a framework by which participants can make progress in their personal recovery. We provide a set of expectations and consequences that reinforce recovery-oriented behavior. Following this structure will enhance the probability of accomplishing recovery.

CREOKS is a strong ally in the road to recovery. A person’s success requires active participation and taking responsibility for making appropriate choices.
