CREOKS is certified and partially funded by the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services and is accredited by CARF International.



**(IPS)** is a program that provides supported employment and education to individuals with behavioral health challenges. This program is an evidence-based practice of supported employment.



IPS supported employment assists those with behavioral health conditions work at competitive jobs of their choosing. Mainstream

education and vocational training are also included as ways to advance career paths. IPS specialists can assist those with disability benefits.
